CROW WING COUNTY TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON LAND USE ORDINANCE REVISIONS AND LAND USE MAP AMENDMENTS

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department is scheduled to hold a public hearing on proposed revisions to the County Land Use Ordinance and proposed amendments to the official Land Use Map on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 in front of the Crow Wing County Planning Commission. The public is reminded that no in-person attendance is allowed at this time due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Proposed ordinance revisions, land use map amendments, supporting information, and information about how the public can join the meeting and participate remotely can be found on the County's website at www.crowwing.us/ordinance.

A 30-day public comment period on the proposed revisions and amendments was previously held from February 5th through March 5th, 2021. The Planning Commission will make a recommendation on the proposed ordinance revisions and land use map amendments to the County Board of Commissioners for final review at a regularly scheduled meeting on or after April 13, 2021.

In addition to the full ordinance being made available for review, a summary of the proposed changes to the Land Use Ordinance and locations of land use map amendments are listed on the County's website.
