CROW WING COUNTY LAND SERVICES SEEKS PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED EXPANSION OF MILLER BLACK BEAR TRAIL

Crow Wing County Land Services is requesting public comment on a proposal to designate 6.25 miles of existing and 6.25 miles of new trail development as an extension to the multiple use Miller Black Bear Trail system. The existing trail system is located in Wolford and Irondale Townships. The proposed expansion includes additional trail segments in Wolford and Irondale Townships, as well as the City of Trommald.

“We encourage all citizens interested in this trail proposal to submit written comments no later than August 30, 2021 at 5pm,” said Environmental Services Supervisor Ryan Simonson. “All comments received will be responded to in writing and presented to the County Board prior to their decision on the proposal,” he added.
