ONE-STOP-SHOP SERVICE NOW AVAILABLE AT COUNTY LANDFILL

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Program is now open Monday – Friday from 8AM – 5PM, year round. County residents can bring in all types of household chemicals for disposal such as cleaning products, pesticides, herbicides, paints, stains, and automotive chemicals. This service is free of charge.

In the past, the HHW program was open 2 days per month from May – October, and then open by appointment only from November – April. “We are moving to a one-stop-shop model where folks can now bring HHW materials as well as recyclables, garbage, and other items for disposal all at the same time,” stated Ryan Simonson, Environmental Services Supervisor.

Upon arriving at the County Landfill site, residents must stop at the Landfill Office. The attendant will discuss the items to be disposed and provide directions to where the HHW Facility is located. Please note that all loads coming to the landfill must be covered to ensure roadways are not littered with debris. Uncovered loads may be subject to additional fees.

The Land Services Department is committed to providing excellent customer service while helping our residents make wise choices that protect Crow Wing County's extraordinary natural resources.
