COUNTY ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY SEASONAL TRAIL CLOSURES

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department will be temporarily closing selected forest trails on county managed lands to motorized vehicles. These closures are due to vulnerable trail surfaces caused by the spring thaw and unseasonably warm winter temperatures. Trail conditions will be periodically monitored by Land Services staff, and when appropriate, the closures will be lifted.

“These temporary closures help us protect vulnerable natural surface forest trails and roads and minimize future maintenance costs,” stated Tom Strack, Environmental Services Supervisor.

Closure signs will be installed at each trail to notify the public. The location and status of all trail closures can be found at <https://www.crowwing.gov/318/Trail-Conditions>. The County is asking citizens to observe these trail closures during spring thaw in order to protect our natural resources.
