Crow Wing County Recycling Center

The Crow Wing County Recycling Center is a One-Stop-Drop for residents recycling and hazardous waste disposal needs. The center is located at the Crow Wing County Landfill site at 15728 State Hwy 210, Brainerd. This service is for residents of Crow Wing County and business hazardous waste/recycling is not accepted.

The following items can be recycled for FREE at this location:

- Household Hazardous Waste
- Batteries
 - ***Batteries must be separated from other waste!***
- Oil, used oil filters, and anti-freeze
- Residential recycling
 - Corrugated cardboard
 - Paper
 - Plastics with a neck **Please rinse*
 - Glass

For a fee the following items can be recycled:

- Electronics / \$5 each
- TV's / \$10 -27" or smaller & \$15 – 28" or larger
- Mattresses / \$30 each
- Propane Tanks / \$7 up to 20 lb tanks & \$15 for 20 -100 lb tanks
- Tires / \$2 - \$140 depending upon size
- Appliances / \$5 each
- Fluorescent bulbs / \$1 for intact bulbs & \$2 for broken bulbs
