CROW WING COUNTY SURVEY RESOURCES NOW AVAILABLE ON WEB-SITE

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department and GIS Department have collaborated to improve the ability to search for survey resources and section corner information within the web based GIS application “WebFusion.”

Crow Wing County has approximately 4,400 public land survey (PLS) monuments that comprise section, quarter and meander corners that form sections and townships which comprise all the sections in the County. Over the last three decades, significant efforts have been made in the field toward recovery and perpetuation of these PLS corners which are the foundation for all private and public land boundaries in the County.

“Having this survey information available on the web-site will save area surveyors time coming in to the County Offices to gather the information” stated David Landecker, Crow Wing County Survey Coordinator. “This should help keep down the costs of surveys.”

Continuing efforts are being made to complete the re-monumentation of all PLS corners in the County. Survey records and other related information that is currently only available by coming to the County for viewing is being assembled for dissemination to the public through tools that will be added in the “WebFusion” application. The protection and unlimited access of all survey records in Crow Wing County is a long term investment that protects and provides benefits to all landowners.

The Land Services Department is committed to providing excellent customer service while helping landowners make wise choices that protect the extraordinary natural resources Crow Wing County is blessed with.
