Child Support Payment Options have Changed

The Child Support Division launched iPayOnline on January 14, 2026, as another option for participants to make payments on their Minnesota Child Support cases.

Most court orders require parents to pay their child support through income withholding, if income withholding is not an option or if a parent needs to make additional payments, there is now another option.

iPayOnline allows noncustodial parents and employers to pay child support using additional payment options that include credit cards and e-wallets such as PayPal, Venmo, Google Pay, Apple Pay and Cash App.

These new options join the other methods of payment accepted which include automatic recurring withdrawal, cash, check, MoneyGram, and PayNearMe.
