BITES FOR LIGHTS' CHRISTMAS LIGHTS RECYCLING PROGRAM

The Crow Wing County Land Services Department, in cooperation with Sunrise Sertoma of Brainerd, and Kenwood Recycling, collected 4,600 pounds of unneeded Christmas lights and extension cords at select locations throughout Crow Wing County in 2013 making this the most successful season for the “Bites for Lights” program.

“The money raised through this program is used to help purchase meals at soup kitchens and local food shelves in the Brainerd Lakes Area” stated Jeff Hilborn of Sunrise Sertoma. The copper found in the old extension cords and Christmas lights is recycled through Kenwood Enterprises, keeping these materials out of the county landfill.

The following groups participated in the program by allowing recycled containers at the business, making it easier for citizens to drop-off old Christmas lights and extension cords throughout Crow Wing County.
