Concrete Curb & Gutter Schedule – Address 7042 to 7338

Thank you for your patience and understanding with the reconstruction of County Road (CR) 115. By early next week, road grading and aggregate base will be complete from CR 127 to Address Number 7338 (approx. 400 feet north of Windy Ridge Road). Concrete curb & gutter placement is now scheduled for **Thursday, September 14**. Once the curb is placed through your entrance, you will not be able to drive over the curb until the next day, when the entrance has been ramped with gravel. If you need to leave your residence during the curb placement, you will have to park a vehicle out on the roadway or have someone pick you up. Again, this only applies to residents between Address Number 7042 & 7338.

Parking Instructions:

Concrete work will begin at 7:00 AM in the morning and finish around 7:00 PM the same day.

Residents needing to leave during curb placement may park their vehicles on the east side of CR 115 before 7 AM on Thursday, September 14th. The vehicle owner will need to move their vehicle at least once throughout the day to accommodate curb installs on both sides of the road. Please speak with the Contractor or County personnel on-site to assist with on-road parking and contractor schedules. Your entrance will be ramped with gravel allowing access on the morning of Friday, September 15th.

Residents arriving to their property on Thursday evening, may park their vehicles overnight on CR 115 along the newly installed concrete curb. Your entrance will be ramped with gravel allowing access on the morning of Friday, September 15th.

When parking along CR 115, please park as far to the right side of the road as possible to allow construction equipment to work on the road.

Alternative parking options – Park along the completed curb segments of CR 115, park north of Address Number 7338 along CR 115, have someone pick you up, or enjoy being at home for the day.

Please feel free to call the County and/or ask the Contractor on the project site for advice on where to park and when the vehicle will need to be moved. Please note that weather could alter the timing of the curb placement.
